**Surgical Statistics**

In 2008, doctors at The Children's Hospital performed 15,956 surgeries. There were 4,411 inpatient surgeries and 11,545 outpatient surgeries. Surgeries performed included heart, liver and kidney transplants, cardiothoracic, dental, gastroenterology, neurosurgery, oncology, ophthalmology, orthopedics, otorhinolaryngology, pediatric surgery, plastic surgery, pulmonary, rehabilitation, and urology.

<sup>7</sup> The Children's Hospital is a Level 1 Trauma Center meaning it provides the highest level of definitive and comprehensive care for patients with complex injuries. Emergency physicians, nurses and surgeons are immediately available to the trauma patient. The top causes of admission to The Children's Hospital trauma center are fall, car crash, non-accidental trauma (child physical abuse), and bicycle crash

<sup>8</sup> In 2008, The Children's Hospital had patients from every county in Colorado and from all 50 US states. There were also patients from Puerto Rico, Germany, Japan, Canada, and Mexico.
